Niigata Short-term Course

Upon completing a short-term course, you will have the opportunity for individual counseling sessions to help you transition to one of our long-term courses, if desired. Application Qualification

- ◎ At least 16 years old at the start of the course.
- ◎ Students under 18 years of age must have a guarantor in Niigata City.
- ◎ If you are currently studying at high school or college, we may ask you to provide proof of enrollment.
- ◎ You can take this course with a short-stay visa.
- ◎ Please note that extension of a short-stay visa for studies exceeding three months cannot be made in Japan.
- ◎ Those who enter Japan with working holiday visas are also eligible to enroll in the school

Entrance

- ◎ At any time.(Excluding long vacation periods.)
- ◎ We recommend that individuals with limited Japanese language experience consider joining regular course students in either April or October.
- ◎ Due to enrollment limits, you may not be able to enter in the course.

Class Level

- ◎ In essence, on the first day of school, we administer placement tests consisting of a written exam and an interview. Students are then grouped based on their proficiency in Japanese language, which may occasionally result in the school recommending students to transfer to a different course.

Class Hours

- ◎ Classes are from Monday to Friday. School is closed on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays.
Classes are 4 hours a day and each class length is 45 minutes.
Dual Sessions: Morning classes and afternoon classes.
Morning Classes: From 9:20 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.
Afternoon Classes: From 13:15 p.m. to 16:40 p.m.
- ◎ Class assignments, whether in the morning or afternoon, are determined based on the results of placement tests. Please be aware that, in certain situations, we may not be able to accommodate specific requests for class schedules. Additionally, please note that extracurricular activities conducted during the short-term courses are considered part of the class hours.

Please make the payment into our bank account as specified in the invoice.

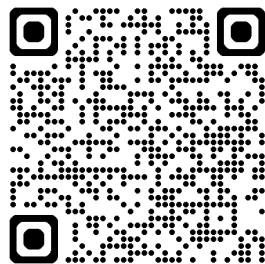
NOTE 1: Kindly ensure that you cover any bank charges incurred both in your country and in Japan.

NOTE 2: As a general policy, all fees paid are non-refundable regardless of the circumstances.

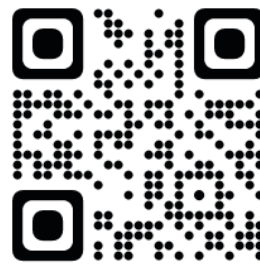
NOTE 3: Payment must be made before the course starts.
